



From the Spiritual Director

Hi! My name is Wayne Melaas-Swanson, and I am beginning a term as Spiritual Director together with Gene Vincent. I attended weekend 21, sitting at the table of Jeremiah. I serve as pastor at Messiah Lutheran Church in Port Byron, Illinois, and sometimes attend with my two "children" Kirsten and Daniel. Sometimes? Well, Daniel is a student at Luther College in Decorah, Iowa, and Kirsten is currently on Rotary Exchange Year in Zimbabwe, Africa. So the opportunities are limited! But we keep in touch - as much as we are able - and both of them are connected with faith communities where they are now primarily living.

Keeping in touch is a good thing. Whether it's with family at home, or our faith community family - whether it's our congregational community, or our support community in Via de Cristo. In our faith journey those connections are vital in helping us continue our walk with Christ. That's the purpose of the 4th Day program in Via de Cristo. It's an extension of the weekend experience, a means of building on that experience to grow further in our relationship with Christ, and in living out our faith in the church and in our communities.

Within the Via de Cristo community there are three ways we can live out our 4th Day walk. First is the Reunion Group. If you haven't connected with a group since your weekend, I encourage you to seek one out - it's a great way to have support in continuing forward in your faith walk from those who have shared the same weekend experience you've been blessed with. Second is the bi-monthly Ultreya, an opportunity to join with the larger Living Waters community for a shared meal, an inspirational 4th Day talk, and a time of worship together. Finally, there is the opportunity to take your weekend experience and share it with others by serving on a weekend team. This last opportunity is not only useful as a way of offering a weekend experience to new people, but a way of reconnecting both with those in the Via de Cristo community and with God in a little different but great way than that first weekend experience.

If you can't serve on a team, there is also the option to help with the weekend by praying for the weekend, inviting new people into the experience, and coming to either the Serenade or the Closura to support those who are on the weekend for the first time.

Community is a vital part of our faith. We are joined with one another in Christ who is our center and who calls us together to be his Body in the world. And community is what defines us as Living Waters Via de Cristo. We aren't a movement or program if we are not a community. So I invite you and encourage you to connect - or reconnect - in one or more of these ways - or to encourage those you know who may not be connecting with the Via de Cristo community. As we connect, we grow, and as we grow, we foster our connection with Christ and become a greater resource to the family of faith we are part of in our local congregations.

In it all, remember the One who is at the center of our life and faith, the One whose love and grace never fails and never runs out. Indeed, God loves you, and so do I.
